Itinerary

Thursday 8th May

Early morning departure for the Eurotunnel Terminal at Folkestone.

12:50 Le Shuttle departs for Calais (35 min).

14:25 *CET.* Arrive France and travel to Vlaardingen.

09:10 Coach departs for Calais Eurotunnel Terminal, en route taking a two-hour break at the beautiful Belgian town of Veurne.
